Paper 1: Thematic study and historic environment

□ Written examination: 1 hour and 20 minutes 30%* of the qualification 52 marks
 □ Medicine in Britain, c1250-present and The British sector of the Western Front, 1914-18: injuries, treatment and the trenches.

Section A: historic environment Students answer a question that assesses knowledge plus a two-part question based on two provided sources.

Section B: thematic study Students answer three questions that assess their knowledge and understanding. The first two questions are compulsory. For the third question, students answer one from a choice of two.

Paper 2: Period study and British depth study

Written examination: 1 hour and 50 minutes 40%* of the qualification 64 marks

□ Anglo-Saxon and Norman England, c1060-88
 □ The American West, c1835-c1895

The American West - Students answer three questions that assess their knowledge and understanding. The first two questions are compulsory. For the third question, students select two out of three parts.

Anglo-Saxon and Norman England - Students answer a single three-part question that assesses their knowledge and understanding. The first two parts are compulsory. For the third part, students select one from a choice of two.

Paper 3: Modern depth study

Written examination: 1 hour and 30 minutes 30% of the qualification 52 marks

□ Weimar and Nazi Germany, 1918-39.

First section students answer a question based on a provided source and a question that assesses their knowledge and understanding.

Second section students answer a single four-part question, based on two provided sources and two provided interpretations.
