## Listening Component (25%)

### What's assessed

Understanding and responding to different types of spoken language

### How it's assessed

1. Written exam: 35 minutes (Foundation Tier), 45 minutes (Higher Tier)
2. 40 marks (Foundation Tier), 50 marks (Higher Tier)
3. 25% of GCSE

(Each exam includes 5 minutes' reading time of the question paper before the listening stimulus is played).

## Speaking Component (25%)

### What's assessed

Communicating and interacting effectively in speech for a variety of purposes

### How it's assessed

1. Non-exam assessment
2. 7-9 minutes (Foundation Tier) + preparation time
3. 10-12 minutes (Higher Tier) + preparation time
4. 60 marks (for each of Foundation Tier and Higher Tier)
5. 25% of GCSE

## Reading component (25%)

### What's assessed

Understanding and responding to different types of written language

### How it's assessed

1. Written exam: 45 minutes (Foundation Tier), 1 hour (Higher Tier)
2. 60 marks (for each of Foundation Tier and Higher Tier)
3. 25% of GCSE

## Written Component (25%)

### What's assessed

Communicating effectively in writing for a variety of purposes

### How it's assessed

1. Written exam: 1 hour (Foundation Tier), 1 hour 15 minutes (Higher Tier)
2. 50 marks at Foundation Tier and 60 marks at Higher Tier
3. 25% of GCSE
