Past papers & Revision

Paper 1: Speaking in French

Worth 25% of the qualification

Students are assessed on their ability to speak French clearly and comprehensibly across a range of audiences, purposes, and contexts relevant to their current and future needs and interests.

The speaking examination consists of **three consecutive tasks**: **Task 1: Read Aloud** (12 marks) **Task 2: Role Play** (10 marks) **Task 3: Picture-Based Task** (12 marks) Followed by a **Conversation** (16 marks)

Paper 2: Listening and Understanding in French

Worth 25% of the qualification

Students are assessed on their understanding of standard spoken French, delivered by one or more speakers, across a variety of formal and informal contexts and in both familiar and unfamiliar settings.

This paper consists of **two** sections:

- **Section A: Listening** (40 marks)
- **Section B: Dictation** (10 marks)

Paper 3: Reading and Understanding in French

Worth 25% of the qualification

Students are assessed on their understanding of written French across a variety of formal and informal contexts, and in both familiar and unfamiliar settings.

This paper consists of **two** sections:

- **Section A: Reading and Understanding** (40 marks)
- **Section B: Translation into English** (10 marks)

Paper 4: Writing in French

Worth 25% of the qualification

Students are assessed on their ability to communicate effectively in written French for different purposes and audiences. They are required to produce responses of varying lengths and formats to express ideas and opinions in French.

All instructions to students are provided in English.
